- Play by the rules, the referees decision is final and should not be questioned
- Respect the other team and shake hands with them and the referee at the end of the game
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me and be prompt for matches and training
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club
- Wear official Whitegrove F.C. kit for every fixture, and keep this in good condition

I understand that if I do not follow this Code of Conduct, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club officials
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of anything I do which breaks the rules of this Code of Conduct.

The FA/County FA could force the club to pay a fine.
