- Respect and do not question the Referees decision
- Team selection rests solely with the team manager, participation in any Whitegrove FC activity is at your own risk and subscriptions are non-refundable.
- Encourage and promote respect within the team, to their coaches, match officials and opponents.
- Do not tolerate or use offensive, insulting, intimidating or abusive language or behaviour.
- Report any concerns to a club official.
- Be positive
- Remain behind the Respect lines at all matches
- Communicate to managers as soon as possible if your child is to be absent/unavailable for any match or training session.
- Remember the club maintains a non-smoking policy
- Ensure that any guests who join you at a match or training abide by this code of conduct
