Training Session	Coaches, Players	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All children must bring their own drink and hand sanitiser to training and these items should be kept separate from the items brought by other children (2m apart) Current social distancing guidelines (2 metres) must still be implemented for warm up and cool down sessions at start/end of training All children must sanitise their hands at the start and end of the session Once any contact training session has started, regular breaks (no more than 20 mins apart) must be taken so children can re-sanitise their hands Hand contact with equipment should be kept to a minimum Do not get children to handle any cones or other training equipment Coaches should wear gloves at all times due to being the ones handling equipment Sterilise any equipment touched (e.g. footballs) after training session 	Players/Parents Coaches Coaches / Players Coaches Coaches / Players Coaches " "
